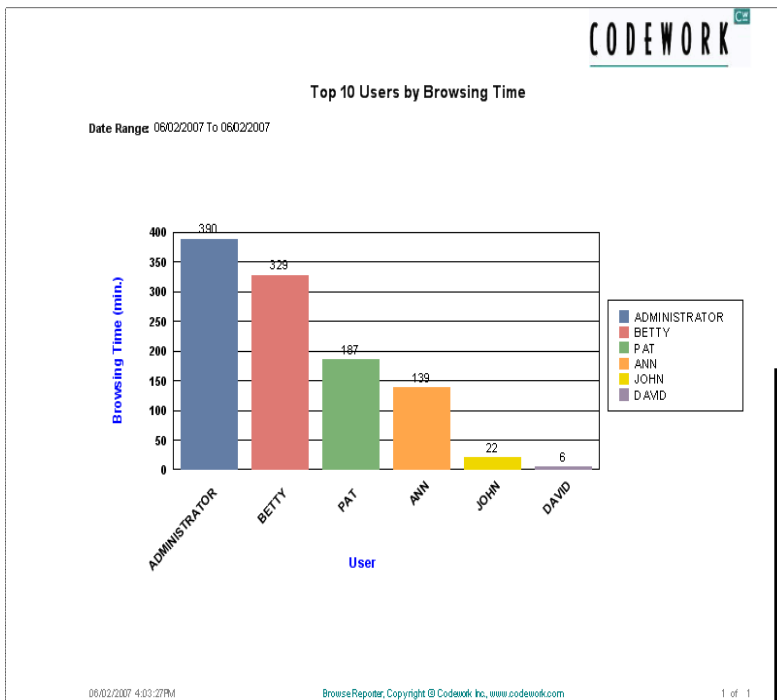


Internet Monitoring Tool

Report on Your Users Internet Access

BrowseReporter is a powerful **web-monitoring tool** that tracks the browsing activity of your employees or students. It is a non-intrusive tool, running in the background without the users knowing that their systems are being monitored.

BrowseReporter includes an extensive reporting utility. Reporting is available at both the executive and detail level in the form of charts and tables.



Monitor the URLs visited by user or by PC.

Tracking and Reporting on Internet Access

- ✓ Monitor web browsing activity on a per user or per computer basis.

User friendly console: Intuitive graphical console for monitoring and reporting on browsing activity.

Email Reports: eliminate the manual task of regularly sitting at the BrowseReporter console, generating endless reports for your manager! Through the new Email Reports feature, you can automatically have specific reports generated and emailed to the manager/administrator on a scheduled basis.

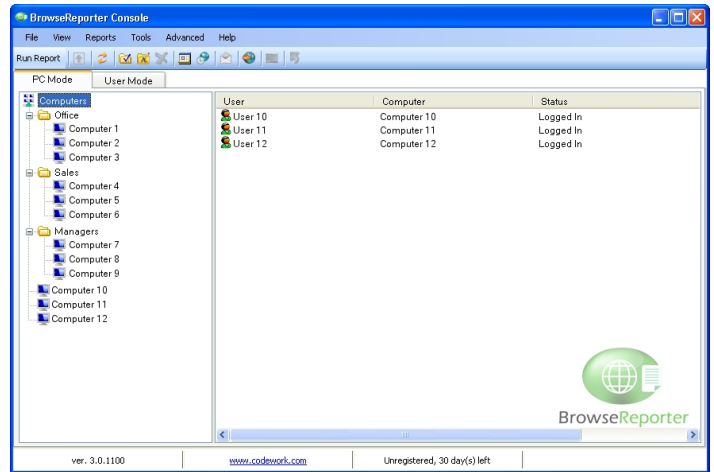
Schedule URL Tracking: collecting the Internet browsing activity at all times may not be necessary. For example administrators may be interested in tracking data only during business or school hours. The URL Tracking Scheduler provides the facility to schedule the days/times to collect browsing data.

Bandwidth Monitoring: track the Internet traffic on your network, to isolate users that are congesting the organization's bandwidth.

Remote Screen Capturing: monitor your users' computer activity by capturing screenshots of their computers.

Export URLs to BrowseControl: Once offensive or authorized sites have been identified through BrowseReporter, the next course of action would be to export this list to your Internet blocking software such as BrowseControl. The Export URL feature will seamlessly export the identified URLs from BrowseReporter to the URL Filter List of BrowseControl.
